

Piper Scott-Fiddler and Samantha Martin-Ferris competed in the World's Challenge Challenge Global Final this week, where they won first prize!



Their proposal was for the Lifegiver Box, a complementary, interdisciplinary, and culturally inclusive program that supports Indigenous people's rights to health by choosing their own needs for their sexual health journey.

It was developed in response to the UN's Indigenous peoples rights to good health as well as in light of the 2022 senate report The Scars We Carry which acknowledged that the systemic erasure of Indigenous bodies is still happening to this day due to forced and coerced sterilization.
