Intersect Job Simulations

InterSECT (Interactive Simulation Exercises for Career Transitions) is an online platform that allows PhD-level scientists (and others!), regardless of professional stage, to explore future career options. Their goal is to provide true-to-life job simulation exercises that help individuals consider the following questions:

- What are my professional interests and skills?
- How do my interests and skills translate to potential careers?
- What are my career options?
- Which careers haven't I considered?

The job simulations are self-guided. Each simulation contains background and directions for you to complete tasks related to the career of interest. You can complete one task of the job simulation in as little as 1 hour, or complete the series of tasks for a deeper dive into a job area.
